Search & Teach is an early intervention program developed to meet the educational needs of young learners (K-1) before they experience the frustration of learning failure. This differs from NILD Educational Therapy[®], which was designed to help students who have documented learning difficulties, and in many cases have already experienced frustration and failure in the regular classroom.

Search is a 20-minute individual test designed to identify 5-and 6-year-olds who are vulnerable to learning difficulty and to provide profiles of individual strengths and weaknesses in the readiness skills necessary for reading success.

Teach is a program of 55 learning activities called tasks, carefully designed to address the needs revealed by a Search screening. Teach is offered to individuals in a one-on-one setting, allowing the student to move through the assigned tasks at the rate of their own development.
