NEW TESTAMENT SURVEY

Mission Statement: SouthLake Christian Academy exists for the sake of God's glory and mission; proclaiming the gospel and discipling the whole person in all aspects of God's reality.

Course Description: Without the Book of Acts it would be hard, if not impossible, to understand the New Testament letters (the books of the New Testament excluding the Gospels). Acts helps answer questions concerning the Apostles after the resurrection and ascension of Jesus Christ as well as the birth of the New Testament Church. Therefore, the Book of Acts provides the backdrop for the course as we journey through Acts from the ascension, to the origin and growth of the New Testament Church. Acts serves as a bridge between the Gospels and Epistles and will assist our understanding of the Theological topics of Ecclesiology (the Church); Pneumatology (Holy Spirit); and Soteriology (Salvation).

Course Objectives: The purpose of this class is to help the student connect the Gospels to the rest of the New Testament and to explore their beliefs of the Church, the Holy Spirit, and their own Salvation. They will develop or enhance a Biblical foundation of their beliefs.

Memory Verses: Some memory work will be assigned as quiz grades and as test grades. (using ESV) The memory verses will be provided and the instructor will inform the students of the format of the assessment (i.e. fill-in the blank or word for word)

Quizzes/Tests: Students are welcome to take notes in class. For some studies, notes will be provided. When notes are provided, the tests will be made directly from those notes. When notes are not provided, the students who take notes will be permitted to use them on the test. Most tests will be open Bible and open notes. NOTE: There is no final exam in this class

Homework: Homework and class work will make up 10% of the overall grade. Homework will be assigned and checked for completion. All students begin the semester with a 100% homework grade. For each assignment not completed, 3 points will be subtracted. For example, if three homework assignments are not completed, then the overall homework grade would be 91%.

Students are required to bring their OWN Bible to every class. The teacher will have unannounced checks throughout the course that will be counted as homework grades. It's an all or nothing grade. Bible in possession = 100. No Bible in possession = 0.

Classroom Expectations:
