## 8<sup>TH</sup> GRADE BIBLE: OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY II

**Mission Statement:** SouthLake Christian Academy exists for the sake of God's glory and mission; proclaiming the Gospel and discipling the whole person in all aspects of God's reality.

**Course Description:** In this second year of their Old Testament Survey, students' will explore the wilderness wanderings through the establishment of the Davidic Kingdom, realizing the covenant structure of the History of Redemption. We will be using *God's Unfolding Kingdom: A Survey of the Old Testament* as our curriculum.

**Course Objective:** That students' may understand God's revelation of himself through His covenant promises including the ability to rightly apply timeless truths found within redemptive history to their own lives.

**Required Text:** The Bible. The teacher will use and recommends the ESV (though not required). Student books will be provided for classroom use only.

**Class Participation:** Students' will be assessed by preparedness and involvement with bringing: Bibles' to class daily, working together in groups, and bringing and taking notes. Every student begins with a full (100%) participation grade. That percentage is reduced as a student comes to class unprepared or unwilling to meaningfully participate in class activities. For each infraction students' will lose 3 points off from their participation grade.

**Quizzes/Tests:** Quizzes and tests will be open Bible covering notes and lecture.

### **Grading:**

- 60% Tests
- 20% Quizzes
- 20% Class participation
- This is a Pass/Fail class with categories (Excelling 90-100, Passing 60-89, and Failing 0-59)

### **Classroom Expectations:**

- Follow all rules and procedures listed in the Southlake handbook
- Follow directions
- Treat your classmates as you want to be treated
- Listen while others are speaking
- Come to class on time, tardiness is tracked at the front office
- Come to class prepared (with your Bible) and ready to learn
- Food (including gum) is not allowed within the classroom except for the designated snack break
