9TH GRADE BIBLE: THE GOSPEL OF JOHN

Mission Statement: SouthLake Christian Academy exists for the sake of God's glory and mission; proclaiming the Gospel and discipling the whole person in all aspects of God's reality.

Course Description: Students' will be doing an in-depth study of the life of Jesus through the Gospel of John. Students' will be exploring both the humanity and deity of the risen Lord and will learn some of the key terms and concepts within John's Gospel. We will be using *The Life of Christ: From the Gospel of John* as our curriculum.

Course Objectives:

- To assist the student in their understanding of the historical background to John's Gospel.
- To assist the student with seeing the purpose of John's Gospel being written.
- To give clarity to the student in their understanding of key terms and concepts as well as applying timeless principles to their daily life.

Required Text: The Bible. The teacher will use and recommends the ESV (though not required). Student books will be provided for classroom use only.

Class Participation: Students' will be assessed by preparedness and involvement with bringing: Bibles' to class daily, working together in groups, and bringing and taking notes. Every student begins with a full (100%) participation grade. That percentage is reduced as a student comes to class unprepared or unwilling to meaningfully participate in class activities. For each infraction students' will lose 3 points off from their participation grade.

Quizzes/Tests: Quizzes and tests will be open Bible covering notes and lecture.

Grading:

- 60% Tests
- 20% Quizzes
- 20% Class participation

Classroom expectations:

- Follow all rules and procedures listed in the Southlake handbook
- Follow directions
- Treat your classmates as you want to be treated
- Listen while others are speaking
- Come to class on time, tardiness is tracked at the front office
- Come to class prepared (with your Bible) and ready to learn
- Food (including gum) is not allowed within the classroom except for the designated snack break
