SPANISH III HONORS

Mission Statement: SouthLake Christian Academy exists for the sake of God's glory and mission; proclaiming the gospel and discipling the whole person in all aspects of God's reality.

Course Description: Honors Spanish III is an advanced course for students who are interested in Spanish and want to prepare for Spanish IV Honors or AP Spanish. It will build upon the skills and knowledge gained in Spanish I and II. Students will be expected to expand their vocabulary range and learn advanced grammatical concepts such as the subjunctive mood. The students will focus on culture through meaningful project-based learning. They will also continue to develop their listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills in Spanish.

Course Objectives: Upon the completion of this course, students should be able to:

1. Converse on an intermediate level.
2. Read on an intermediate level.
3. Write with consistent spelling and grammatical accuracy.
4. Continue learning about the history and culture of Latin America and Spain.

Evaluation

- **Tests and Projects:** 80% semester grade
Each nine weeks will include 3 major test grades. Projects will also be averaged as a test grade.
- **Quizzes:** 20% semester grade
Quizzes will be given 1-2 times per week.
- **Extra credit:** not available per school policy.
- **Missed work:** It is a student's responsibility to find out what was missed after an absence.
Ask a peer first for notes or missed work, then, if questions remain, ask the teacher.
- **Late assignments:** 10 points deduction from the project's final grade per day it is turned in late.

Classroom Policies

- **Attendance:** Will be taken promptly at the beginning of class.
Anyone arriving after the bell rings must return to the office for a tardy slip.
- **Leaving the Class:** Students are not to visit their lockers or make phone calls during class.
- **Bathroom:** Each student will receive **4 (four)** bathroom passes per quarter.

Technology

- **RenWeb:** Is the primary means of communication concerning assessments, schedule changes and available class documents.
- **Email:** Serves as the communication vehicle between students and parents. Parents and students are expected frequently check their provided email addresses.
- **Internet:** Will be used for research, presentations, and streaming media activities.
- **Online Translators:** Google translate, or other online translators are prohibited. Use of a translator is considered cheating worthy of a zero and administrative attention.
