11TH GRADE BIBLE: SYSTEMATIC THEOLOGY

Mission Statement: SouthLake Christian Academy exists for the sake of God's glory and mission; proclaiming the gospel and discipling the whole person in all aspects of God's reality.

Course Description: This course is an introduction to Systematic Theology that focuses on teaching major bible doctrines as they are found in the scriptures (primary authority), creeds, and confessions of the church.

Course Objectives: The student will learn major Bible doctrines and learn how to defend these doctrines against a multitude of errors.

Required Text:

- Bible
- Handouts

Tests: The average of all Tests will make up 70% of the grade. Tests are usually unannounced, open note, open Bible and open book.

Quizzes: Quizzes 20% of grade and are unannounced.

Homework: Homework and class work will make up 10% of the overall grade. All students begin the semester with a 100% homework grade. For each assignment not completed, 3 points will be subtracted. For example, if three homework assignments are not completed, then the overall homework grade would be 91%.

Students are required to bring their OWN Bible to every class. The teacher will have unannounced checks throughout the course that will be counted as homework grades.

Semester grade:

The total grade for the semester will be based as follows:

- 70% Test
- 20% Quizzes
- 10% Home work

NOTE: There is no final exam in this class

Classroom expectations:

- Follow all rules and procedures found in Southlake handbook
- Be punctual. Tardiness is tracked at the front office.
- Bring bible, notebook and writing utensil to class daily.
